SANITARY SEWER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS - July 2012

As part of the Combined Sewer Overflow Plan, the Department of Utilities has identified approximately 3 miles of sanitary sewer mains requiring rehabilitation.

This construction contract includes the replacement of 11,500 feet of sewer line with new PVC or HDPE pipe, the cured in place pipe lining of approximately 4,000 feet of existing sewer, the replacement or rehabilitation of 75 manholes, and site restoration.

At their April 11, 2012 meeting the City Council awarded the Sanitary Sewer System Improvement Project #12-035 construction contract in the amount of \$2,792,920.00 to John Rocchio Corporation for this project.

The City Council also retained the services of the City's design engineer for the project, AECOM Technical Services, to provided construction oversight.

Construction is scheduled to start on July 16, 2012. The Department of Utilities will be distributing notices explaining the proposed work to the residents on the streets scheduled for sewer repairs as the work progresses.

The following streets or portions thereof will have sewer mains rehabilitated:
