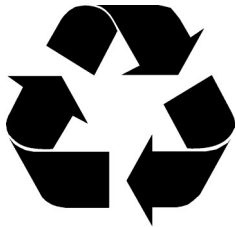
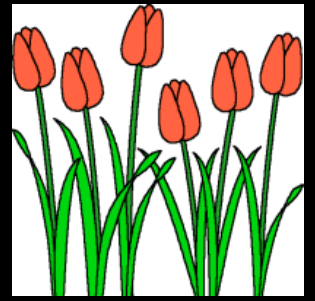


Clean City Program's Spring Recycling Day

RECYCLE

Shred paper

Paper shredding service (paper will be recycled): Four banker box size limit. Manila file folders, hanging files, staples and paper clips are ok to shred. Residents will be served on a first come, first serve basis. Once the truck is full, we will not be able to take additional documents for shredding.

Electronic waste

TVs, computers/CPUs, monitors, mice, misc. computer parts and wires, keyboards, fax machines, modems, routers, laptops, VCRs, DVD players, scanners, cell phones, and more. **NO** small appliances (hair dryers, blenders, etc), Freon bearing items (air conditioners, dehumidifiers), batteries, household appliances (microwaves, etc)

Plastics

#3-7 plastics, plastic toys, buckets, lawn furniture, milk & soda crates, laundry baskets, kiddie pools & sand boxes, plastic totes, plastic landscape edging, plastic drums (food grade only), flower pots (no soil), pet carriers, coolers, dish drainers, shelving, closet organizers, 5-gal water bottles, recycling bins, waste baskets, garbage cans and more.

Clean plastic only. Please remove any wood, metal, glass, wires and batteries from plastic

REUSE

Bicycles

Working and "salvageable" bicycles will be accepted for recycling. The East Bay Met School refurbishes bicycles. Students learn bicycle mechanics & go for bike rides. The bikes are also used in the community.

Books

Book donations for Reading Tree: paperback, hardcover, any age level, DVDs, VHS tapes. **NO** magazines, phonebooks, catalogs, books with mold or mildew

REDUCE

Big Sisters

Big Sisters of RI accepts donations of "gently used" items: anything made of cloth (clothing - all ages & genders, sheets, towels, curtains, blankets, area rugs, table linens, throw pillows, etc. as well as unusable clothing/fabric) Household items - home décor, kitchen items such as plates, glasses, vases, etc. Books (must have cover), toys, games, stuffed animals, etc. Small appliances and electronics in good working order, such as blenders, mixers, radios, etc. **RESTRICTIONS:** NO car seats, cribs, electronics (computers, TVs, etc), broken items, magazines, newspapers, plants, water heaters, mattresses, tires, car parts, lawnmowers, wall-to-wall carpeting

The Earth Machine compost bin will be offered for just \$45 each (includes tax - retails at over \$100). Recycle food scraps and yard waste yielding a natural fertilizer. Newport residents only can call the Clean City Program 845-5613 to preorder by April 28. You must preorder to take advantage of this sale. Pick up your bin on May 1 at the Spring Recycling Day and pay by check at the event. Visit www.earthmachine.com for details on the compost bin and what materials are compostable.
