## Park Bench Donation Policy:

If you are interested in donating a park bench to one of our many participating state parks, you first need to contact the Regional Manager of the park you are considering donating the bench to. There are restrictions as to which parks can receive benches and how many each park can receive. The Department of Environmental Management Division of Parks and Recreation has chosen a specific bench for all donators to use, based on many qualifications. A bench has been chosen because it fits into the park and beach landscape, providing a useful long-term purpose for the visiting public as well as specific color and size so all donated benches will match. Once you have contacted the Regional Manager of the park you are interested in donating to, they will set up a meeting with you to discuss where your bench site will be located, prior to purchasing the bench. Once these steps have been taken care of you will be put into contact with DEM's chosen bench company; O'Brien and Sons. They will help you set up your bench, payment and delivery. The park staff will install at the location once the park bench has been delivered.

Each bench will be a Dumor Bench #58 from the O'Brien & Sons company.

The bench will be six feet in length, in dark green with a 2" x 10" cast bronze plaque with donators chosen engraving on it. See picture below:

-  Regional Manager and the Purchaser will decide on a location within park.
-  Purchaser will call O'Brien and Sons for purchasing arrangements.
-  Park staff will prepare site and permanently install bench at site, once the bench is delivered to park at NO cost to the donator.
