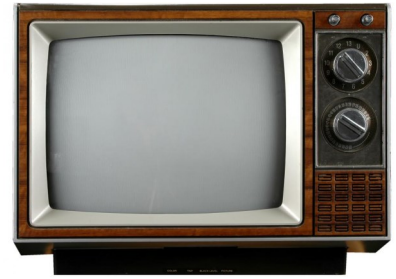


Recycling options for your...



Free Drop offs Available for ALL RI Residents at:

- Little Compton
- Narragansett

Will only accept computers, laptops, monitors and televisions

Fee based disposal:

- Best Buy, call ahead for details (\$25)
- Indie Cycle contact phyllis@indiecycle.com
- Bulk Waste Sticker (Purchase at City Hall)
- Transfer Station (fee determined by Waste Management Inc.)

Staples- in store recycling for free call ahead:

- Desktop and all-in-one computers
- Laptops, tablets, e-Readers
- Monitors
- Desktop printers, copiers, scanners, faxes, multifunction devices
- Shredders
- UPS/battery backup devices (with or without included battery)
- Computer peripherals including mice, keyboards, modems, routers and computer speakers
- Small electronics including mobile phones, MP3 players/iPods, calculators, GPS devices, digital cameras, camcorders and cordless phones
- Digital projectors, CD/DVD/Blu-ray players, gaming devices, A/V receivers, video streaming devices, cable/satellite receivers
- External hard drives and small servers
- Rechargeable batteries (if 11 pounds or less)

Residential homeowners have access to two free dumps up to 500lb each per fiscal year at the Waste Management Transfer Station, with proper identification.

Eco Depot holds special events throughout Rhode Island for the collection of E-Waste, all RI residents are eligible to participate. In order to reserve a spot you must call ahead (401)942-1430 ext. 241.

If it works **just donate it!** On Aquidneck Island there are several different places to donate electronics such as; St Paul's Thrift Store or Salvation Army. Call ahead for more information.
