A. Green Infrastructure Presentation:

The Value of Green Infrastructure Techniques: those that employ landscapes which mimic nature in storm water management, and their applicability to City improvements, regulations and the comprehensive plan.

This presentation is part of a two-year initiative, funded by the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation, aimed to demonstrate the use of green infrastructure techniques in coastal areas, and provide guidance and recommendations to three pilot municipalities to assist in reducing the impacts of flooding from storms and sea level rise. The City has partnered with the URI Coastal Resources Center & RI Sea Grant program and Warwick and South Kingstown to educate community decision makers and use pilot sites to demonstrate the efficacy of these techniques, as well as apply them to regulatory and financial systems to promote their use, when appropriate. The pilot site in Newport is on Marine Avenue, near the Cliff Walk.
