#### **Application Summary:**

The Applicant and Owner seek relief under Section 17.108.020 (Special Use Permits), of the Zoning Code for a modification of the existing Special Use Permit ("SUP") for the property located at 2 Kay Street. The modification of the SUP will allow for two events to take place on September 29, 2022 and September 30, 2022, between the hours of 4:00 pm and 7:00 pm as part of the Audrain Motor Week.

The Applicant, Audrain Automobile Museum, Inc. has secured approval from the City Council for a global, community wide Special Event License for their multi-day, multi-site 2022 Audrain Newport Councours Motor Week. The subject property located at 2 Kay Street was used in 2019 and 2021 as part of the events relating to Motor Week. During both years, the "Hilltop Hangout" took place at 2 Kay Street late in the afternoon as a low key outdoor event for cocktails and cigar sampling. The exact same function is being proposed for the afternoons of September 29<sup>th</sup> and September 30<sup>th</sup> as part of the 2022 Motor Week schedule.

In 2019 and 2021, this same event took place at the subject property and was approved by the Zoning Officer as part of his review of the community wide Special Event License for Motor Week. This year the Zoning Officer originally approved the use of 2 Kay Street again for this function, only to reverse his decision and take the position that the existing Special Use Permit for the property needed to be modified to accommodate a special event associated with Audrain Motor Week.

This application is a request for a modification of the existing Special Use Permit to allow only two specific events on two specific days, to wit, September 29, 2022 and September 30, 2022. A copy of the Special Event License Application and the detailed supporting documents relating to the 2022 Audrain Newport Councours Motor Week is attached hereto and made part hereof.

#### What provisions of the Comprehensive Land Use Plan are applicable to this project?

The Applicant states that the Application is consistent with many provisions of the Comprehensive Land Use Plan, including, but not limited to the following:

Goal LU-1:	To provide a balanced City consisting of residential, commercial, and
	employment uses consistent with the character, environmental resources and
	vision of the community.

Policy LU-1.7: The City shall protect the existing character of residential neighborhoods while encouraging local neighborhood business.

Goal ED-1: To develop a robust and diverse economy, providing suitable employment opportunities for residents, and a stable tax base.

Policy ED-1.1 The City shall support key economic drivers while also seeking to attract and grow its technology sector and businesses that represent new and innovative concepts and technologies.

Policy ED-1.5 The City shall build upon thriving sectors to develop a more substantial year-round tourism economy.

Policy HC-3.1 The City shall foster and work with other organizations in their efforts to enhance the city's museums, libraries, art, theater, musical and cultural institutions.

#### The Zoning Boards Role

Special use permits shall be granted only where the zoning board of review finds that the proposed use or the proposed extension or alteration of an existing use is in accord with the public convenience and welfare, after taking into account, where appropriate:

- 1. The nature of the proposed site, including its size and shape and the proposed size, shape and arrangement of the structure;
- 2. The resulting traffic patterns and adequacy of proposed off-street parking and loading;
- 3. The nature of the surrounding area and the extent to which the proposed use or feature will be in harmony with the surrounding area;
- 4. The proximity of dwellings, churches, schools, public buildings and other places of public gathering;
- 5. The fire hazard resulting from the nature of the proposed buildings and uses and the proximity of existing buildings and uses;
- 6. All standards contained in this zoning code;
- 7. The comprehensive plan for the city.

The burden of proof in a special-use permit application is on the applicant. This means that if the applicant fails to present adequate competent evidence to prove the applicable standard for issuing a special-use permit has been met, the board must deny the application.







Floor plan of the Audrain Automobile Museum Gala.








Layout of the Hilltop Hangout at the Hilltop Inn.













## TENT LAYOUT FOR THE VIP WELCOME DINNER

This layout shows where the tables, bars and stage will be set up inside the tent for the VIP Welcome Dinner which will take place on the lawn of Ochre Court.








## FIELD LAYOUT FOR THE GATHERING AT ROUGHT POINT

This layout shows where the display cars will be lined up on the lawn of Rough Point. Also shown is the approximate locations of tents, tables and restrooms.







The Audrain Automobile Museum, Inc. and its wholly owned subsidiary, Audrain Concours Foundation, LLC (collectively, the "Museum"), respectfully request that the Honorable Members of the Newport City Council consent to the Museum's use of four (4) and six (6) seat, 2018/2019 Yamaha golf carts on public right-of-ways (primarily on and around Bellevue Avenue) during the 2022 Audrain Newport Concours & Motor Week scheduled for Thursday, September 29, 2022 through Sunday, October 2, 2022. (Pictures of the golf carts are attached at 2. c.)

The Museum intends to employ no more than twenty (20) carts at any one time on City streets. Trained, fully insured, Museum employees holding valid, state-issued driver's licenses will operate the carts, each with headlights, back running lights and a top speed of 15-20 MPH, to transport staff, volunteers and equipment to and from event venues, including the International Tennis Hall of Fame, Ochre Court, Rough Point and The Breakers. The streets that the Museum intends to use include Gammell Road, Bellevue Avenue, East Bowery Street, Annandale Road, Narragansett Avenue, Ochre Point Avenue, Sheppard Avenue, and Ruggles Avenue. (Highlighted maps of the streets to be used by the Museum are attached at 2. b.) Former Rhode Island State Trooper, Lieutenant Francis Sullivan, and former East Greenwich, Rhode Island Chief of Police, Thomas Coyle III, will train Museum employees on the use of the carts and on public safety best practices. Each Museum employee assigned a cart will return the cart daily to a private, secure storage location where it will be inspected by a trained mechanic and washed.

The Museum's reasoning for using the golf carts, as opposed to automobiles, is to reduce vehicular traffic and congestion and to alleviate parking stresses and challenges. The Museum is cognizant of the accommodations the City and its residents are making in support of Motor Week and it is taking the steps it believes necessary to increase the City's profile and reduce the inconveniences Motor Week may create.

The Council approved the Museum's use of twenty (20) golf carts at the 2021 Motor Week. The Museum's golf cart usage during the 2021 event was without incident or complaint.









