PLANNING BOARD

The Planning Board is the steward for Newport's Comprehensive Plan, which sets the long-term vision for the City and is a key measure by which large development projects and zoning relief are evaluated.



Time Committment

MEETINGS ARE HELD MONTHLY DURING EVENING HOURS AT CITY HALL. TYPICAL MEETINGS CAN LAST APPROXIMATELY 2-4 HOURS WITH SPECIAL MEETINGS AND WORKSHOPS ARE HELD AS NEEDED. BOARD MEMBERS ARE ASSISTED BY CITY STAFF WITH RELEVANT EXPERTISE.

The Zoning Board of Review is responsible for overseeing and enforcing the City's zoning code in a fair and equitable manner.

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HISTORIC DISTRICT COMMISSION

The Historic District Commission is comprised of a body of volunteers appointed by the City Council and advised by the City's Historic Preservation Planner. Together, they are responsible for overseeing development within the Historic District.
