PRESIDENTIAL PREFERENCE PRIMARY
JUNE 2, 2020

WHEREAS, under Title 17 of the General Laws, 1956, as amended, and pursuant to Governor Raimondo's Executive Order #20-11, **TUESDAY, JUNE 2, 2020** has been designated as the day for the Rhode Island Presidential Preference Primary.

NOW, THEREFORE, in accordance with the provisions of said Laws and Executive Order, ALL electors residing and qualified to vote in the City of Newport are hereby warned to assemble on said Tuesday, the 2nd day of June, 2020 A.D., between the hours of 7:00 A.M. and 8:00 P.M. in the location designated below for the purpose of casting in-person ballots:

PELL ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, 35 DEXTER STREET

Voters who have applied for a mail ballot should return their ballot directly to the RI Board of Elections in the postage paid envelope provided, to be received NO LATER than June 2, 2020.

ANY voter who has requested a mail ballot and presents themselves at the polling location will be required to cast a PROVISIONAL ballot. Mail ballots CANNOT be voted or surrendered at the polling location.

If you did not apply for a mail ballot, and may not be able to vote in-person at the above location on June 2, 2020, you may contact the Newport Canvassing Department at (401) 845-5384 to arrange for an EMERGENCY ballot. Emergency voting will be conducted May 20, 2020 8:30 A.M. through June 1, 2020 4:00 P.M. by appointment only.
