

Pre-Hire Minimum Requirements

- Minimum of 21 years of age as of 10/8/2021.
- HS or GED Certificate.
- Ability to successfully pass each phase of examination process.

Post-Hire Requirements

- Enrollment, participation and successful completion of the Rhode Island Municipal Police Academy.
- The passing of a psychological evaluation, physical and drug screens.
- Must be able to perform essential job duties of a Newport Police Officer.



- Fully complete an Employment Application and attach a copy of your birth certificate; HS/GED diploma; valid State driver's license and DD-214 military form (if applicable) with application.
- Submit application & documents with a \$20.00 non-refundable testing fee (cash or check payable to City of Newport) to HR on or before the deadline date of Friday, October 8, 2021.
