

# Welcome to Newport

During the summer parking season, Downtown Newport tends to be congested with traffic, and on-street parking is difficult to find. **As the largest** of the City's surface lots, visitors are encouraged to park at the Newport Gateway Center at 23 America's Cup Avenue.

# Paid Metered Parking

On-street parking spaces utilize seasonal parking kiosks located throughout the downtown area and at various points around the City.

In addition to paying via credit card or cash at the meter, motorists are also encouraged to pay via the **Passport Parking App.** Simply park where you see Passport Parking signs & decals, pay for your parking session from your phone, and be on your way!

#### MARY STREET PARKING LOT

118 Spaces Between Mary & Church Street Daily, 24 Hrs, 7 Days/week

\$3 per hour / \$20 per day / \$30 Overnight

#### **Discounts**

3 Hours Free Once Per Day with Resident Sticker. Must enter registration plate number in Kiosk or Passport App

#### LONG WHARF LOT

(31 Spaces) Long Wharf Daily, 24 Hrs. (with a 9 hour limit)

#### Rate

\$2.00 per hour

#### **TOURO STREET LOT**

(30 Spaces) Accessible from Clarke Street 8 a.m. - 9 p.m.

#### Rate

\$2.00 per hour with a 3-hour limit

## **Metered Parking Season**

Metered parking is in effect 9 AM - 12 AM dailv. including Sundays in the Downtown Area, from May 1st through October 31st. 9 AM -**9**PM in other metered areas. Please refer to posted signs. Pay by Plate at multi-space kiosk or use the Passport Parking App.

#### **November 1st - April 31st**

No fee for parking, but a 3-hour limit remains in effect until 6 PM

#### Rates:

Beach Meters on Memorial Blvd:

\$2 per Hour: 3 Hour Limit

Downtown Area & Cliff Walk

\$1.50 - \$2 per Hour: 3 Hour Limit (4 Hour Limit at Cliff Walk/Narragansett Avenue)

#### **Discounts**

2 hours free once per day at on-street metered spaces with Resident Sticker. Must enter registration plate number in Kiosk or use Passport App.

# **Residential Parking Zones**

Residential Parking Sticker Program is in Effect from May 1st through October 1st.

Specific streets throughout Newport may be designated as Residential Sticker Parking

Please note parking on Residential Sticker Parking streets is restricted to vehicles with Residential Parking Permits ONLY.

Signs are posted on streets where Residential Permits are required and the hours in which they are in effect (24 hours, 6 PM - 6 AM, or 6 AM - 6 PM). Please review signage carefully.

# **Other Parking Restrictions**

- Street signs are posted where parking is prohibited or time-restricted.
- Parking for more than **24 Hours** is Prohibited
- Parking is prohibited at Yellow Painted Curbs
- Accessible Parking Spots are available for those displaying a valid placard on a firstcome, first-served basis, and are NOT subject to meter fees, time limits, or residential sticker parking restrictions.
- Motorcycles are prohibited from on sidewalks at all times.
- Up to four motorcycles may be parked in one metered space. Please note that there limited motorcycle-only parking spaces located throughout the City.
- Fishing permits for restricted areas are available at City Hall from September 1st through April 30th of each year.
