
\$20 per car Weekends and Holidays Season passes are available for a fee at City Hall.

Metered parking is in effect 9:00 AM through 9:00 PM daily, including Sundays, from May 1st through October 31st Parking meters accept coin or credit cards

November 1st through April 30 th No fee for parking at meters but a 3 hour limit remains in effect until 6:00 PM.

Rates: Beach Meters on Memorial Blvd:

\$2 per hour-3 hour limit

Downtown Meters:

- \$1.25 per hour-3 hour limit
- Narragansett Ave. Pay by Plate 4 hour limit

PARKING RESTRICTIONS

Residential Sticker Parking Program In effect from May 1st through October 1st

Specific streets are designated as Residential Sticker Parking street by City Ordinance. Parking on Residential Sticker Parking streets is restricted to vehicles with Residential Parking Permits.

Signs are posted on streets where Residential Permits are required and the hours in which they are in effect (24 hours, 6 PM- 6 AM, or 6 AM- 6 PM). Please review signage carefully.

Other Parking Restrictions

Street signs are posted where parking is prohibited or time restricted.

Parking for more than 24 hours is prohibited

Parking is prohibited at yellow painted curbing.

Accessible parking spots are available for those displaying a valid placard on a first come first served basis, and are not subject to meters, time limits or residential sticker parking restrictions as a courtesy

Motorcycles are prohibited from parking on the sidewalks at all times. Up to four (4) motorcycles may be parked in one metered parking space There are limited motorcycle only parking spaces located throughout the City.

Fishing permits for restricted areas are available at City Hall from September 1st through April 30th of each year
