Boys & Girls: Grades K-2

DEADLINE TO REGISTER: DEC. 15

This program is meant to teach the very basic fundamentals of basketball with a heavy focus on drills and fun activities to improve skills play and less focus on game play.

RIYBA TOURNAMENT TRAVEL TEAMS

DEADLINE TO REGISTER: NOV. 1

For eligible Newport & Middletown Residents, these tournaments are highly competitive, involve a good deal of travel and can be as many as three or four games over the weekend, including Friday evenings, weekly practice and. Contrary to our house leagues, tournament teams do not have equal play rules, although many coaches strive to do so. It may be necessary to make cuts for these teams. (TBD practice dates and times based off gymnasium/ coach availability).

Eligible grades: Boys and girls in grades 4-8

Tryout Fee: \$25 (must register in advance)

Tryout Dates: Times/Dates TBD after registration
(early November)

RIYBA Fee: \$125

- If player makes the team, the \$25 tryout fee will be applied toward the RIYBA fee of \$125.
- If player does not make the team, the fee will be put in the system as a household credit for future registration.
- **You must be registered in the In-House Basketball Program in order to play on a RIYBA travel team** (unless on Thompson or Gaudet Middle School teams)
