# Welcome!

Newport Recreation is excited to be able to offer your child a summer camp experience they will enjoy. It will be different and there will be changes, but the one thing that remains the same, is that it will be FUN!

# Age Groups

Per the recommendation of the CDC, we will be keeping our campers in small, set groups.

Each group will consist of a maximum of 13 campers and 2 staff members.

Each group will have their own set of supplies and equipment.

Red, blue and green groups will be at Vernon Park.

Purple group will be at Aquidneck Park

**RED** - Boys and girls entering grades K-1 in the fall

**BLUE** - Boys and girls entering grades 2-3 in the fall

**GREEN** - Boys and girls entering grades 4-5 in fall

**PURPLE** - Boys and girls entering grades 6-8 in the fall

***There are no exceptions or changes to the age groups.***

# Hours and Registration

Camp Hours: 8:30 am - 4:00 pm

NO before or after care available.

Camp will be offered in weekly sessions beginning June 29th and ending August 21st.

Participants may only register for a full week. No daily registrations accepted.

## Registration:

Newport residents beginning June 7th.

Non-residents beginning June 14th

## Cost per child per week:

Newport residents: \$105

Non-residents: \$125

One week's payment is due at the time of registration. A non-refundable deposit of \$15 per week may then be placed on any additional weeks you may need. Payment for each of those weeks will be due 72 hours in advance.

A limited amount of financial assistance will be available to Newport residents ONLY

Space is extremely limited and will be on a first come, first served basis.

# Drop Off and Pick Up Procedures

\*Each group will have their own drop off and pick up area. Red and blue groups will be on the Vernon Ave end of the park and the green group will be at the Freeborn St. side. The purple group will be checked in at the playground area of Aquidneck Park. (King St.) NO campers are to be dropped off at The Hut.

\*Campers and parents must remain in the car until a staff member checks you in

\*All campers will have their temperature taken and will be asked a series of health screening questions. Once cleared by the staff member, campers ONLY will exit the vehicle, use the hand sanitizer supplied, and then enter the park.

\*The check in process will not begin until 8:30 am and will be done in the order of arrival. Please plan accordingly. Please be patient and safe!

\*Pick up will also be curbside. Parents must remain in the vehicle. Please be sure your camper car tag is visible. A staff member will then bring your child to your car.

\*In the event of rain, camp MAY be cancelled. More information will be provided before the start of camp

# What To Expect Each Day

- \*All staff members will wear cloth face coverings when social distancing is not possible
- \*Campers will not be required to wear a face covering during the day.
- \*Campers within the small groups will not be expected to keep physical distance from one another. Unnecessary or excessive contact games and play will be redirected and reconfigured to minimize the contact, but campers will experience social interaction
- \*Each group will remain together throughout the entire day and will not interact with any other groups.
- \*Each group will have their own equipment and supplies
- \*We will be following all recommended cleaning and disinfecting procedures throughout the day.
- \*Participants and staff will use hand sanitizer frequently throughout the day.
- \*Any child that presents with a fever, cough or other COVID-19 symptoms will be isolated from the group immediately and a parent will be contacted.
